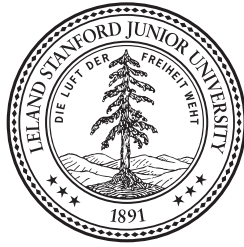

All course enrollments must be designated towards the major or minor programs. By informing the Center for Latin American Studies (CLAS) which courses are intended to satisfy the Global Studies with concentration in Latin American Studies (GS-LAS) minor, the student allows CLAS to accurately monitor progress toward the minimum requirements for the GS-LAS minor. Students should file this form at least two quarters before their intended graduation, and not later than the Final Study List deadline.

INSTRUCTIONS

STUDENT:

1. List the courses (including elective courses) to be used to satisfy your major(s) and any minor requirements. Include those courses already taken and those you intend to take.
2. Make an appointment with CLAS Advisor to go over your plan and obtain the advisor's signature.
3. Make and maintain a copy of the completed and signed form for yourself.

CLAS PROGRAM:

Be sure that all of the courses required for the completion of the GS-LAS minor are listed on the attached form. When you have verified that the GS-LAS minor requirements do not overlap (double count) with those of the major(s), sign in the space provided.

Your signature indicates that the courses proposed as satisfying the requirements of the GS-LAS minor do not overlap with those of the major(s). Your signature *does not* indicate that the student has completed all of his or her major or minor requirements, as she or he may not yet have completed some of the listed courses.

Retain a copy of the signed form. The form should be on file in CLAS *before* recommending a student for the GS-LAS minor on the Final Recommending List.
